Experiential Land-Based Learning

At Seventh Fire, Land-based learning runs year round across subjects like science, humanities, art, and physical education. Students complete courses approved by the Ontario Ministry of Education, working towards achieving their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

This helps students develop problem-solving skills, deepens their ties to the Land, and build lasting respect for nature.



Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR)

- Available to students 18 years or older.
- Earn credits from life experiences or employment history.
- Demonstrate knowledge through tests, assignments, and presentations.

Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP)

- Begin exploring skilled trades in Grade 11 or 12.
- Earn high school credits while training as an apprentice.
- Pathway toward becoming a certified journeyperson.
- Meets requirements for OSSD.

PATHWAYS

Co-operative Education

- Combines classroom instruction with workplace placements.
- Students earn credits through real-world experiences.
- Partnerships among students, employers, schools, and parents/guardians.
- Prepares students for College, Apprenticeship, and Employment.



Independent Study Program

- Earn Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) from home.
- Designed for flexible, self-paced learning.
- Age 14 or older.
- Requires a credit evaluation session to determine appropriate courses.
